

Twenty-seventh Sunday of the Year 2nd October 2016 p. 146 of book

Faith is a strange quality! It is about a relationship. Faith can determine one's identity. It entails knowledge. There are times it may be tested. Perhaps it may lie dormant or feel as good as dead. Faith is a gift. The apostles ask Jesus to increase their faith in today's Gospel passage from St. Luke. Jesus proceeds to speak about a faith which may be as small as a mustard seed and yet work miracles. Why do the apostles ask the question? Jesus spoke (last week) about the Rich Man and Lazarus - a shocking passage for some. Then he proceeds to speak about forgiveness - forgiving seven times a day! (This is not mentioned in the Lectionary.) After this comes their appeal to the Lord to increase their faith.

How would you describe the state of your faith today? Has it always been like this? Is it weaker or stronger than it was in the past? What circumstances have helped shape it or undermine it? Who has been influential? Reflect this week on your relationship with Jesus who forgives us and asks us to forgive one another, who defines who we are as children of God through our bond with him, who teaches us about God and heaven. Ask God to fan into a flame the gift of faith which you have received. Don't be afraid to let your faith however small grow into a mighty force which can transform your own life and do amazing things for others.

This weekend I begin my 9th year in Welwyn Garden City! Time flies...I am still very happy here and I feel privileged to be your Parish Priest. I am so grateful for the support and encouragement I receive. Please continue to pray for me as I do for you every day. May God bless each one of us in the particular mission he has entrusted to us. May our enthusiasm for faith and zest for life be infectious and a force for good here in our town.

CAFOD HARVEST FAST DAY takes place this Friday. Please take an envelope from the back of church and return it in the retiring collection on Sunday. This year CAFOD are inviting parishioners to make a regular gift through their *Hands On* project. *Hands On* supports specific communities as they undertake a project to transform their lives. Everyone who signs up will start by following an innovative project on the Altiplano in Bolivia, which will support people with seeds, materials and training to help them grow enough food.

CONFIRMATION Young people (at least in Year 9 at school) who wish to be confirmed should come with their parents to a meeting on Sunday 9th October at 7pm at Our Lady's Church. Preparation starts in November.

RCIA If you are an adult who wishes to join the Catholic Church or if you are a Catholic who missed out on Confirmation when younger and now feel ready to be confirmed, come to Our Lady's Sacristy on Monday 3rd October 7.30pm. There will be a chance to meet others and find out more about what is involved.

ST. ALBANS Bishop John Sherrington will be preaching at an Ecumenical Evensong at St. Alban's Abbey Cathedral on Saturday 8th October at 4pm for this Year of Mercy. Bishop John would like all the schools of Hertfordshire to lead a procession from Verulamium Park at 2.30pm which will enter the Abbey and prepare for Evensong. There will be an enactment of the martyrdom of St. Alban with massive puppets, music and prayer. Everyone is welcome.

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD (SHOEBOXES) We are again be supporting this charity by filling and sending shoe boxes to children in need around the world particularly migrants and refugees. Filled boxes, knitted hats, scarves, gloves/mittens can be brought to St. Bonaventure's or whichever church you attend as soon as you have them ready.

MOTHER AND TODDLER at St. Bonaventure's. This informal and friendly group meets every Wednesday from 10am. Come and let your baby or toddler play whilst you enjoy the company of other mums, grandparents or carers. All are welcome from our three parishes and from the local community, no need to let anyone know you are coming - just turn up.

HERTS WELCOMES SYRIAN FAMILIES Catherine Henderson of HWSF is going to Calais on Oct 7th and has been asked to take smartphones plus chargers that anyone isn't using. These are to be given to the children who they are afraid may be scattered when the camp is demolished and who will be at risk from traffickers. If you have a working smartphone plus charger or any mobile that you no longer need could you drop it into 106 Handside Lane, by Wednesday 5th - they can be put through the letter box if no one home. Thanks.

SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSFER It is important for parents to go to school open days/evenings with their children and see the options available. Read the admissions criteria carefully to ensure you have a good chance of getting into the school if it is oversubscribed. Get hold of your child's Baptismal Certificate in good time. Think about the environment in which your child will flourish. In terms of the Certificate of Catholicity, the form will be given by the schools and will have to be signed by Fr. Norbert. The Certificate of Catholicity is a statement that the child comes from a practising Catholic family which means there is attendance at Mass every week. To facilitate this, Fr. Norbert will give out an 'extra' form for WGC parishes for parents to fill out for him. These can be collected from him *before or after Mass*. Meetings will be as follows: Tuesday 4th October 4 - 6pm, Monday 10th October 4 - 7pm, Friday 14th October 4 - 6pm. when parent/s and child will come to meet with Fr. Norbert at Our Lady's Church. Please contact Kathryn Hubbard on 01707 322579 to book a 10-minute appointment. The same process will apply for entrance to Reception Class and then Nursery later on in the year.


