



Thirty-third Sunday of the Year 13th November 2016 p. 164 of book

Today we gather for Mass on Remembrance Sunday. There is the solemnity of the ceremonial, the sadness at the loss of loved ones and a wealth of memories. This year's commemoration carries with it the election of a new President of the United States of America. I have a radio by my bed and through Tuesday night I kept putting it on 'sleep' so that I could hear an hour's worth of news and then doze off again. Finally the NEWS came through of a result. Whatever our own personal feelings about what has transpired, it is a sign that much in our world is changing at home and abroad: the way people think, what they aspire to and the willingness to venture into the unknown are now apparently traits of a new world order. In my years I have seen change without measure resulting from the fall of the Berlin Wall and the complications of the Middle East. Some of you will recall the Second World War and a new order emerging with its end. There seem to be cycles of history each revealing something new or unexpected.

The Gospel reading from St. Luke proclaimed today points is to the 'end'. Jesus speaks of people hearing about wars, revolutions, earthquakes, plagues, famines; he says there will be persecution, betrayal and imprisonment. It all sounds so frightening! The Lord then says that this will be our opportunity to bear witness and that he will give an irresistible eloquence and wisdom; not a hair will be lost - our endurance will win us our lives. In other words, don't give up, keep trusting. There is a job to be done! What do you think is the message the Lord wants you to give to others? What kind of witness is it possible for you to offer?

We begin the final week of the Jubilee Year of Mercy. Let us thank God for the blessings received and let us pray, pray with all our hearts that we will continue to be merciful and allow our God to lavish his mercy upon us. Surely this could be a message the world continues to long for and see in us - mercy made concrete in our way of living. What enduring witness!

May God bless you and may God grant eternal rest: to those who have died for our freedom and to all our deceased loved ones. ***Fr. Norbert***
