
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



John the Baptist has arrived! Every year in Advent we have two Sundays which include the presence and ministry of this mysterious figure. This Second Sunday of Advent, John is to be found in the desert - a wild and desolate place. People flock to him to hear his message, to be baptised and to encounter God's grace.

John calls out: 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand!' Repentance is a change of heart, a refocussing of our lives and perspectives, putting God first and keeping him in our sight. There seem to be so many people making their way to the Baptist and St. Matthew tells us that they aree ready to confess their sins and want to be baptised. It all seems very Lenten, don't you think?! Indeed there have been periods in the Church's history when Advent has had a very austere and penitential feel. Now the Church invites us to be joyful and filled with anticipation at the Coming of the Lord. Don't forget though that it is the Second Coming we still await as well as celebrating what happened at the Nativity! For this reason, John's voice is crucial at this time: whatever gets in the way of the Lord's Coming we must work at to eradicate; even though we know he has come already and put our trust in him, we cannot leave it at that; a constant renewal of our lives enriches us and keeps us vigilant.

Secondly, the kingdom of heaven is close at hand. This kingdom comes in Jesus. When we encounter him and grow in love of him, we are welcoming the kingdom into our lives, and experience and share the joy and grace of God's Reign. What do you regard as the 'values' of this kingdom? Think about the Beatitudes from the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5). Open yourself up to the power of the parables of the Talents (where we discover that so much has been entrusted to us and must be used) and the Last Judgement (where Jesus says he is to be found in the person in need) - both in Matthew's 25th Chapter.

So as we begin this second week in Advent, let us find our 'deserts'. Let us pray and reflect on renewal in our lives, especially through repentance. And let us allow God's kingdom to come in us through Jesus his Beloved Son. God bless you.
