

Another Lent has begun! As you think back over the years, have there been 'Lents' which have stood out for you because you were successful, or because of a difficult situation which you were able to over come? Maybe you managed to heal a rift with someone else or saved huge sums for the poor and marginalised? Perhaps you had an amazing experience of prayer way beyond anything you thought possible? What is the purpose of Lent? What is the purpose of YOUR Lent? What does the Church hope will happen?

This week I heard broadcasters on the radio committing themselves this Lent to giving up crisps - salt and vinegar crisps...the ultimate sacrifice! There was no question about the undertaking nor any explanation of why - it just seemed to be the natural thing to do! Have you made up your mind to give up something? Will it be your favourite food/drink/habit? Have you thought of doing something extra and are sure this addition to your life will enrich you? The Church wants us to bear fruit in charity, prayer and spiritual training. She, as a mother caring for her children, urges us to focus totally on the source of life and salvation - Jesus Christ - and to be renewed by his Passion, Death and Resurrection. Lent is a time of testing as Jesus was tested by the Devil in the wilderness. Lent is a time of growth in our relationship with God just as we see new life spring up in nature. There will be Stations of the Cross: Wednesday 10am at Holy Family, Friday 10am at St. Bonaventure's and 7.30pm at Our Lady's.
