

OUR LADY.

Second Sunday of Lent 12th March 2017 p. 155 of book

Jesus takes with him Peter, James and John and they climb a high mountain where they can be alone. The three chosen disciples have the privilege of witnessing the Transfiguration of Christ - glory beyond measure radiating from Jesus, God's Son. How lucky they were! What an awesome sight! In Lent, Jesus invites us to spend time with him alone. Where is your place of solitude? How high do you have to climb? Is it hard work or does it come naturally? During the Lenten journey what glimpses has the Lord given you of the glory to come? Have you opened your heart to someone in need in a way never done before? Has your hand reached out to another with forgiveness and mercy? Has your life of prayer deepened to such a degree that you have felt overwhelmed? Has God given you an insight into an aspect faith which you had struggled with? Have you been transfigured with Christ or feel the development taking place with his help? I have asked many, many questions! The answers are not always self-evident and the ability to keep on searching for a response will lead us to echo Peter's words to Jesus: 'Lord, it is wonderful for us to be here...'

After the Last Supper, this same group of disciples is invited by Jesus to go with him deep into the Garden of Gethsemane as he leaves behind the others. They witness Jesus experiencing sadness and great distress. They fall asleep and leave Jesus on his own to pray that God the Father's will should be done and not his. When Jesus returns to his sleepy companions he tells them: 'The spirit is willing but the flesh is weak.' As followers of the Lord, our task is to be with him in moments of glory as well as in the depths of suffering, to walk up the various hills and mountains and to pick up ourselves with him when we fall, to carry the heavy load of our own crosses as well as to support him as he takes upon himself the burdens, sins and sufferings of the whole world. We have to learn to say with trust at these moments too: 'Lord, it is wonderful for us to be here!'

As we start another Lenten week, let us recommit ourselves to being with Christ wherever he wants to lead us and to trust that he is there. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
