

Twenty-fourth Sunday of the Year 17th September 2017 p. 128 of Mass book

Today is designated as Home Mission Sunday. The Church in this country invites us to think of our hearts as 'homes'. Who is important in your life? Who depends on you for care, support, love and affirmation? What events have you shared with these people: happy, sad, ordinary? How have these people influenced the kind of person YOU are? Hopefully there are many people who spring from your heart into your mind. Deep within your soul, say 'Thank you' to God for them. As you reflect on the gift of these people in your life, consider Jesus: his friendship, the salvation he brings, the power of eternal life. Do any of your loved ones who live in your heart, need to hear from you fresh news about Jesus? Now the tough part! Try to find just the right words to express what is at the heart of your faith, why Jesus matters to you, what it is about the Church which inspires you and keeps you going through the ups and downs of life. Someone who loves you will surely respect you in what you hold dear? That person would listen? What extra aspect might you need to offer which would make a difference to them at this stage in their lives? This is 'mission'! This is an encouragement which can transform. This is the Gospel as Good News being proclaimed.

In our Gospel passage from St. Matthew, Jesus tells us about forgiveness - forgiveness from the heart offered as many times as is necessary. It might be something small; it could be a huge offence. He asks us to forgive in the way God our Father is ready to forgive us. Just think about the Lord's Prayer, the Our Father, which we recite so often. Today as you pray these words, dig deep into your heart and bring to the Lord people you find it hard to forgive; ask him to help you to be open to those who are asking you for forgiveness. This gift of mercy-put-into-action is definitely a treasure which will reconcile hearts and minds, leaving souls at peace.

FIRST CONFESSION & FIRST COMMUNION Sessions for the parents of the children for First Confession and First Holy Communion will take place early next year. Children for Confession and Holy Communion are in Year 3 or above. At St. Bonaventure's the children have classes once a month on Saturdays - the Enrolment Meeting will be on Saturday 7th October at 11am in St. Bonaventure's Hall (with the first class on Saturday 14th October). At Holy Family Church the classes are weekly usually on a Wednesday afternoon after school starting in January/February - the Enrolment Meeting will be in Holy Family Church after 9.30 Mass on Sunday 5th November. At Our Lady's Church the classes are on Sunday mornings before 11.30 Mass starting in January - the Enrolment Meeting will be on Tuesday 14th November at 7.45pm in Our Lady's Church.

CONFIRMATION Young people from our three churches in Year 9 and above at school are invited to come with their parents to an Enrolment Meeting for the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday 15th October at 7pm in Holy Family Church. The course will begin in November.

An open morning allows you to see the school in action and the way the pupils and staff are. Think about where your child will flourish, taking into account his/her gifts, travelling, friendship groups and what schools offer. Definitely read the admissions criteria and try to see whether or not your child has a good chance of getting in. Some Catholic schools will need a Certificate of Catholicity which implies weekly attendance at Mass. Fr. Norbert will be available in October (dates and times will be in the newsletter) to sign these certificates. All Catholic schools will need a Baptismal Certificate, so now is a good time to request one if you have not got the original. If the Baptism was here in Welwyn Garden City, contact Kathryn Hubbard (01707 322579); otherwise make sure you give yourself time to acquire one from the church of Baptism.
