Twenty-seventh Sunday of the Year 8th October 2017 p. 137 of Mass book

'...the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a people who will produce its fruit.' Another set of hard-hitting words from the mouth of Jesus which he directs at the chief priests and elders of the people at the end of today's Gospel parable from St. Matthew. What do Jesus' protagonists make of it all? These words are uttered in the Temple. Just imagine the scene. In the holiest place possible, the religious leaders are subjected to a barrage of challenges from the Lord!

When I reflect on parables, I often think about the kingdom being the 'reign of God' - God living and working within each one of us, transforming lives by the grace of his love, taking us to eternity. What does it mean to have it taken from someone? From the chief priests and elders? From me? From you? To me it sounds very destructive; however, it is a gift which is going to be entrusted to those who will produce fruit. The religious leaders of Jesus' time have allowed their understanding and living out of God's call to become an obstacle, preventing people from sharing in God gracious reign. The lowly people are too important to God and Jesus is making sure that they find a place in the kingdom.

Let us consider our own lives. Do we regard this kingdom as being a present, a gift? Has it become embedded in our lives? Is it affecting the way we live and love? Do those around us notice that there is a special quality to our faith such that there are fruits evident - signs that the kingdom is well and truly alive and flourishing? If we are honest with ourselves, should we admit times when we have become blocks to the Lord and become barriers to the kingdom's growth? Now is the time to do something about it! Repentance takes humility and courage; repentance necessitates change. What a difference that can make to our own lives and to the joy of introducing people to God-in-Christ! Have a wonderful week. Feel the blessings Christ brings. Offer him to others!
