

## Twenty-ninth Sunday of the Year 22nd October 2017 p. 143 of Mass book

'Very well, give back to Caesar what belongs to Caesar - and to God what belongs to God.' This is the punch-line at the end of today's Gospel passage from St. Matthew. Not many words and yet the interpretations are so diverse! As you read these words here, what do you think they really mean? Are you aware of the context within the Gospel narrative? How would the people of Jesus' time have regarded them when they considered their own religious background?

Some like to jump to the conclusion that Jesus implies a separation of Church and State some things belong to the State and some pertain to God and religion. This very much reading into the words our own framework of understanding and present day questions! It is interesting that Jesus himself does not appear to have the denarius coin in his pocket! Is that because of his poverty or as an act of defiance against the Roman occupiers or because he does not want to pay tax? We do not know for certain. The Pharisees do not come themselves to Jesus with their trap; instead they send their disciples to do the dirty work! The latter are even accompanied by the Herodians, collaborators from the court of a puppet king. What a combination!

One commentator on this passage feels that in Jesus' mind, these words might be translated as: 'Give to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, but don't forget that you belong to God.' A piece of metal has Caesar's image engraved on it; so let the coin be given back to him (in tax). We have been created in God's image and likeness; we belong to God - our whole being, our aspirations, our desires. How does that strike you? Moreover, as Christians, we can say with confidence that Jesus is calling us to share in a Kingdom beyond compare, to be play a part in the Reign of God, to worship God alone and Jesus Christ whom he has sent in the power of the Holy Spirit. This is what really matters.

At present there is so much going on in the realm of politics both at home and abroad with various slogans being bandied here and there. It is very easy to fall into the trap of going with the flow. Take time this week to reflect on Jesus' words. Ponder what he is really saying and respond! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*

FIRST CONFESSION & FIRST COMMUNION Sessions for the parents of the children for First Confession and First Holy Communion will take place early next year. Children for Confession and Holy Communion are in Year 3 or above. At Holy Family Church the classes are weekly usually on a Wednesday afternoon after school starting in January/February - the Enrolment Meeting will be in Holy Family Church after 9.30 Mass on Sunday 5th November. At Our Lady's Church the classes are on Sunday mornings before 11.30 Mass starting in January - the Enrolment Meeting will be on Tuesday 14th November at 7.45pm in Our Lady's Church. At St. Bonaventure's the children have classes once a month on Saturdays. (If you missed the enrolment meeting, please contact Kathryn Hubbard). CONFIRMATION Young people from our three churches in Year 9 and above who missed the enrolment meeting for Confirmation should contact Fr. Norbert as soon as possible. The course begins after half-term.

**MONTHLY ADORATION** Some parishioners have offered to lead a monthly Holy Hour with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, worship music and reflections. It will take place on the second Friday of the month at Our Lady's after 7pm Mass with a 7.45pm start. There will be Benediction to conclude. The name chosen for the hour is 'Restoration'. The first Restoration Holy Hour will be on Friday 10th November. Everyone is welcome.

The Tuesday 7pm Mass at Our Lady's will be a Vigil Mass and then on the day there will be Masses at 9.30am at Holy Family Church, 12 noon at St. Bonaventure's and 7pm at Our Lady's. Parishioners are also welcome to attend 9.15am Mass at Holy Family School or 2pm Mass at Our Lady's School.

**ALL SOULS DAY** on Thursday 2nd November is a Day of Prayer for those who have died, commending the faithful departed into God's merciful hands. Prayer for the dead is an important part of our Catholic way of life. The Masses will be as follows: 9.30am Holy Family, 12 noon St. Bonaventure's and 7pm Our Lady's.
