

Nativity of the Lord 25th December and Sundays up until 14th January

'I bring you news of great joy...today a Saviour has been born to you...Christ the Lord.' This is the message from the Angel to the shepherds in St. Luke's account of the Nativity...and the rest is history! As we gather as a Christian Community to share in celebrating Christ's Birth - coming together with family, friends, parishioners and visitors - the impact of what has taken place sinks in!
