

'Who is this?' is the question which we must ask ourselves at the end of today's Gospel passage from St. Mark. The man possessed by an unclean spirit declares: 'I know who you are: the Holy One of God!' Jesus releases the man from his affliction and everyone is filled with wonder. How do you feel? What's your response to the question? What is it in your life and its experiences which convinces you of Jesus' identity?

In the account, we are told of Jesus' teaching. We do not know its content but we are aware of the authority with which the Lord speaks. This teaching is not only in words but is evidenced in the healing which takes place. What strange 'teaching'! Those involved in education are often asked to look for 'outcomes'; they are to treat their children and students as individuals ensuring that each develops, is stretched and grows. Would Jesus have passed the inspector's watchful glance and demanding criteria? (That's not a fair comparison!)

In our own lives, can we honestly say that our faith is shown in words and actions? Last week, we heard about the calling of the first disciples; from their nets and boats along the Sea of Galilee, they find themselves following this magnetic personality straight to the synagogue in Capernaum. Now they witness the wonder of his teaching authority through the healing. What must they have thought? Perhaps they asked themselves: 'Is he going to expect us to copy him?' or 'Are we going to be able to speak and act with such authority?' Maybe you have the same thoughts running through your minds? To be authentic all the time - with words and actions to match - is challenging; to go out of our comfort zone and reach out to the sick, the disturbed, those who are different, takes the courage of a true disciple empowered by the Lord to be come his apostle.

May Christ be with you this week inspiring you with words and actions, putting those you encounter in touch with him! *Fr. Norbert*
