

Fifth Sunday of Lent 18th March 2018 page 170 of the Mass Book

'Sir, we should like to see Jesus' is the request made by the Greeks to Philip in today's reading from St. John's Gospel. Philip goes to Andrew and the two go to tell Jesus. The Lord speaks for some time elaborating on what will happen to him and a voice from heaven confirms his word. It is not clear whether or not the Greeks get to see Jesus in the way they expect! Something much deeper will unfold.

In St. John's Gospel 'seeing' is vital in drawing us into an understanding of who Jesus really is. Seeing is believing! A relationship is created and one beholds the Son of God. 'When I am lifted up from the earth...' are words at the end of today's passage. Soon the crowds will see Jesus lifted up on the Cross, pouring our love for the salvation of the world. His execution becomes a glorification; his dying brings eternal life. Jesus is the grain of wheat falling to the ground and bearing much fruit. This is the mystery of Easter!

Our joy and responsibility is to look out for the presence of Jesus. He enters Jerusalem on a donkey. He shares a Last Supper with those closest to him and washes their feet. He is betrayed and denied by friends. He carries a cross to Calvary. He breathes his last. On Easter Day the Empty Tomb is found. Perhaps the Greeks got a lot more than they bargained for! Maybe they just wanted to gawp at the wonder worker they had heard about. Now - if they are willing to walk in his footsteps - they see him being treated brutally but willingly giving himself as a Paschal Lamb. The Beloved Disciple sees and believes. That is our task too!

Soon we will enter Holy Week. The Sacred Triduum - Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil taking us into Easter Sunday - is the most important time in the Church's Year, beckoning us to come and see Jesus, to experience his love and to recommit ourselves in faith to him as we journey through life. This week let us reflect on the words 'We should like to see Jesus' and find ways of discovering him anew and putting others in touch with him.
