

## Twenty-fourth Sunday of the Year 16th September page 132 of the Mass Book

Last weekend in Liverpool, around 10,000 people gathered for the Eucharistic Congress. It was a powerful testimony to the vibrancy of the Catholic Church in the midst of much which has gone wrong in recent times. A moving 'moment' was the Blessed Sacrament Procession which Fr. Tom and I took part in by carrying the Blessed Sacrament in a monstrance on a plinth. The heavens opened and the rain came down. People, priests, bishops and the Cardinal got drenched! At the steps of Liverpool Cathedral the clouds parted, the sun shone and Cardinal Nichols gave the Benediction. What a contrast! There was such pride in being a Catholic that day and bearing witness to our belief that Jesus Christ is truly present in the Consecrated Host.

What does it mean for me to believe that Jesus is the Christ? What difference does it make for me to be a Christian? Can I be identified as a follower of Jesus? These are some interesting questions we might ask ourselves today as we ponder the Gospel reading from St. Mark.

Peter is inspired to declare that Jesus is the Christ. He has come to know him as God's Anointed One, called to carry out God's work. Jesus then explains that the Son of Man must suffer, be put to death and rise after three days. The very same Peter - the Rock - crumbles to smithereens because he cannot accept this crucial aspect of Jesus' identity as Christ and Son of Man! Jesus says to him: 'Get behind me, Satan!' The passage concludes with the Lord inviting everyone gathered to be ready to carry their crosses and follow him.

As St. Mark relates this account to his community, what was he saying to them? What is the message for us? Many scholars would say that St. Mark's Gospel was set in writing for the Christian Community in Rome where they faced huge persecution from the Emperor Nero. Their lives were at risk and so it was essential that they understood fully who Jesus Christ truly was and that their personal commitment to him would give mutual support to believers and prepare them for the possibility of death. When Christians were confronted with suffering, the fact that their Lord and Master suffered would have given them courage, hope and strength.

Look again at the questions above. Ask yourself what your honest answers might be. See if your relationship with Jesus can 'fire' you up to let others know about him! God bless all you do and support your witness to his Son Jesus. *Fr. Norbert*

For those applying to Catholic Schools a Certificate of Catholicity is required which affirms that a child comes from a practising Catholic family, i.e. a family which attends Mass every week. Fr. Norbert will in due course publish dates to meet up with children and their parents/guardians to fill out the relevant forms. It is crucial to read a school's admissions policy to see if your child has a good chance of getting in.

**RCIA** Are you interested in joining the Catholic Church or knowing more? Are you a Catholic adult who missed out on Confirmation when you were younger? Now's the time to think about the next steps! Pray. Talk to another Catholic. Come to Church and deepen your experience of being with others. The first session for our three parishes will be on Monday 1st October at 7.30pm in Our Lady's Sacristy.
