

Twenty-ninth Sunday of the Year 21st October page 146 of the Mass Book

'Since in Jesus, the Son of God, we have the supreme high priest who has gone through to the highest heaven...' These are the opening words of our Second Reading today from the Letter to the Hebrews. How powerfully the Author takes the image of priest and expresses the movement of Jesus to heaven, achieved through his Passion, Death and Resurrection. And from his place in heaven, Jesus lavishes mercy and grace upon us. Let's turn now to the longer version of our Gospel passage from St. Mark. Just before we enter the this text they are on the road, going up to Jerusalem, with Jesus walking on ahead. His disciples are in a daze and apprehensive! What happens next? The two brothers James and John want the best seats in heaven! Thrones, crowns and places to the right and left of the Lord - what a request! 'Can you drink the cup I must drink or be baptised with the baptism with which I must be baptised?' is Jesus' question to the pair and their response is affirmative. Little do they realise that the glory of Jesus will come about by his being lifted up on the throne of the Cross, his crown will be made out of thorns and it will be two criminals who will accompany him at that point, sharing in the shame of crucifixion. They forget that three times he has predicted his fate; they have short or selective memories! However, Jesus then offers them his own understanding of his Mission: to give his life in service as a ransom for many. His priestly work of sacrificial love sanctifies us and calls on us to journey with him to the glory of heaven - the new Jerusalem.

What does all of this mean for us? Why did St. Mark record the events of today's Gospel? To show up the disciples? More likely to challenge us to remember the cost of discipleship. We have to learn to walk with the Lord, to be of humble service to others, to be ready to suffer and be united with Jesus. We cannot run away from this fact, The marvellous Gift is of God's Son who is merciful and offers us grace to support our efforts.

Remembrance Day The 11th November this year has great significance as we mark the centenary of the end of the First World War. As well as the Services in Howardsgate (at 10.45am) and Hatfield Hyde (at 3pm), there will be the ringing of church bells at 7.05pm (including St. Bonaventure's and Holy Family!) For this reason at the end of Holy Family's 6pm Mass there will be 15 minutes of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with Benediction leading into the ringing of the bells of Holy Family.
