

The first newsletter of 2019! How have these weeks been for you? I have just returned from visiting my friend, Fr. Alvaro, who is University Chaplain in Seville and who was 40 last Monday. I had never made a surprise trip in this way with a host not expecting me! Some amazing experiences included having to celebrate a weekday Mass completely in Spanish (with a couple of days' notice); going out late at night with the Caritas Group - made up of university professors and students - to visit the homeless, talk to them and offer them a smile and hot soup; watching a 400-year old carved 'corpus' of Christ, which had been restored, being hoisted back into position in the University Chapel - I was asked to help pull the rope to raise Jesus to a height, making me ponder what it was like on that first Good Friday for Jesus to be lifted up on the Cross. The birthday celebrations also went really well!

In our Gospel reading today we are with the Mary, Jesus and his disciples. We find ourselves at a wedding feast where things go terribly wrong with the wine running out. Our Lady notices what has happened. Jesus is her Beloved to whom she turns. The servants are the ones asked to 'Do what ever he tells you.' Water is then turned into wine - the very best ...and the party continues! There are times in life when things can go pear-shaped for us, no matter how much hard work or thought we have put in. We can feel so let down. And yet Mary our Mother reminds us to put our trust in her Son. He can do all things and the power of his activity has its source with the Father. As we embark on a new year, it is vital to remember that Jesus brings something fresh into our lives: divine love, compassionate care, reconciling grace and the desire to draw us deeply into his 'hour' of exaltation. May 2019 be a year of blessing for you, your families and friends. May the presence of Christ strengthen the bonds of community as we listen to him, carry out what he asks and share with others the wonder of our faith.

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY The main Service for Welwyn Garden City will be at Herts International Church on the Mundells roundabout (AL7 1FT) today (Sunday 20th) at 4pm. It would be wonderful if many of you from our three churches joined our fellow Christians. The Baptist Regional Minister Geoff Colmer will give the address. The Service will last around 40 minutes and be followed by refreshments.

HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL DAY is on 27th January and remembers the six million Jews murdered during the Holocaust, the millions of people killed under Nazi Persecution and in subsequent genocides in Cambodia, Rwanda, Bosnia and Darfur. 27th January marks the anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau, the largest Nazi death camp.

There will be a unique event 09:30 - 11:30 - Hawthorne Theatre followed by a Civic Memorial Service outdoors at The Campus West Arena delivered in partnership by Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, The Welwyn Hatfield Interfaith Group and our local secondary schools. Doors open at 09:00am. Refreshments will be served in Campus West Terrace Suite at 11.30am where you will have the opportunity to browse an exhibition of a range of themed art pieces and written work created by local young people.

PEACE SUNDAY The Bishops of England and Wales invite us today to pray for peace and reflect on Pope Francis' message entitled: 'Good politics serves peace'. Think about the following words: 'Peace involves work; it is not about staying calm and doing nothing. No! True peace means working so that everyone has a solution to the problems, to the needs, that they have in their land, in their homeland, in their family, in their society.' (Pope Francis 2015) 'In Germany, first they came for the Communists, and I didn't speak out because I was not a Communist. Then they came for the Jews, and I didn't speak out because I was not a trade unionist. Then they cam for the Catholics and I didn't speak out because I was a Protestant. Then they came for me - and there was no one left to speak out for me.' (Martin Niemoller, Lutheran Pastor imprisoned by the Nazis)
