
# WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Second Sunday of Lent 17th March page 157 of the Mass Book

We have only reached the Second Sunday of Lent! How are things going? I have already been told off when eating chocolate biscuits or sweets with the strict voice of a parishioner saying 'It's Lent, Fr. Norbert!' We have had non-stop purple each day with no feasts to break up the austerity of penance. This week St. Joseph's Solemnity breaks into our Lent with the opportunity to cherish the Guardian who took such good care of Jesus, giving him the security of a home, the dignity of a trade as carpenter and a role model of a husband in the wonderful, humble way he loved Mary, wanting the very best for her no matter how hard it must have been for himself. In another week and it will be the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord which will mean just nine months to Christmas!!!! Isn't it so easy to look ahead and forget about the present moment?

Today we are high on a mountain with Jesus caught up in prayer! St. Luke tells us that Jesus was transfigured - such an amazing event foreshadowing the glory which is his as Son of God and as the One who would suffer, die and rise. Each of the Synoptic Gospels has an account. The Synoptic Gospels are Matthew, Mark and Luke; they can be read almost in parallel and have many similarities though there are some marked differences. St. Luke emphasises that the Transfiguration happened as Jesus prayed; in Luke's Gospel prayer is often a springboard for something significant. Jesus, we are told, talks with Moses and Elijah about his passing *exodus* - which surely makes us think of the departure of the Israelites from Egypt, their journey to the Promised Land and their conviction that God was on their side. For us as Christians, Jesus is the Paschal Lamb whose sacrifice we will celebrate at Easter. It is he who wants to save us and his self-offering affords us the grace of passing over from sin/death to forgiveness and eternal life.

May God continue to be your inspiration, drawing you even deeper into the riches of his love revealed in Jesus. Have a good week! *Fr. Norbert*

**PRIESTHOOD AND RELIGIOUS LIFE** Are you interested in answering God's call? Why not go to an evening of prayer and conversation with like-minded people on Sunday 24th March at 6pm at St Joseph's Church, Bedwell Crescent, Stevenage SG1 1NJ. Westminster Diocese Vocations Team will be at 6pm Mass. Seminarians and others will speak about their calling. After Mass there will be an opportunity to relax and speak to each other and to priests, religious and seminarians about the call of God, closing with Night Prayer at 8pm.

**LENT** During the Season Lent, there will be **Stations of the Cross** on Wednesdays at Holy Family (after 9.30 Mass) and Fridays at St. Bonaventure's (after 9.30 Mass) and at Our Lady's after 7pm Mass. There will be **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** for 30 minutes on Mondays at Our Lady's after 9.30 Mass), Thursdays at Holy Family (after 9.30 Mass) and Saturdays at St. Bonaventure's (after 10am Mass). There will be the **early morning 6.30 Mass** at St. Bonaventure's on Friday 5th April and the **Restoration Holy Hour** at Our Lady's on Friday 12th April after Stations of the Cross (around 8pm). The **Sacrament of Reconciliation** (Confession) will be as usual on Thursdays at Holy Family (10.00 - 10.30am), Saturdays at St. Bonaventure's (10.30 - 11.00am) and at Our Lady's (5.00 - 5.30pm). The Confirmation Group will lead Stations of the Cross on Friday 29th March at Our Lady's at 7.30pm followed by Confessions when a number of priests will be available. The main Service of Reconciliation for Welwyn Garden City will be in Holy Week on Tuesday 16th April at 8pm at Our Lady's.

**CAFOD FAST DAY** was last Friday (15th). As you leave Mass today there will be a retiring collection for CAFOD - the Catholic Agency for Overseas Development. If you are a tax-payer and are able to GiftAid your contribution that would make a big difference too. Thank you for your generous response.

**CARDINAL'S LENTEN APPEAL** is another way of observing Lent. Take one of the special envelopes from the back of the church. Money raised through this appeal will support areas of Diocesan life: Marriage and Family Life, Youth and Evangelisation, the Church's Service in Society which now will include a new programme focusing on food poverty. Envelopes can be put in the church collection and will be sent on.

**MARRIAGE PREPARATION** The Marriage Preparation Day for Welwyn Garden City will be next Saturday (23rd) at Our Lady's from 10.30 am until 5pm. There will be the Blessing of Engaged Couples at 6 o'clock Mass that evening. Whether you are marrying here in our town, in another part of this country or abroad, a Preparation Course is required. Couples marrying in 2020 are most welcome too!

**SIGNED MASS** Shell Roca, Director of the Deaf Service of the Diocese will be coming to help with the signing of Mass on Saturday 30th March at 6pm at Our Lady's. There will be two 'practice' sessions to prepare on Tuesdays 19th and 26th March at 7.45pm for an hour in the Sacristy of Our Lady's. Those who took part in the Deaf Awareness Course should let Fr. Norbert know if they can come. Others too may come to these sessions but the maximum number for a fruitful session would be 16 people. After Mass on 30th March, there will be a bring and share gathering in the sacristy. All are welcome.
