

Fourth Sunday of Lent 31st March page 169 of the Mass Book

Every three years on this Fourth Sunday of Lent, the Church presents us with the picture of a parent who shows unconditional love, reaching out to each of his two children and reminding them of their importance. We know the parable principally as 'The Prodigal Son'; however, it is really about a Father who never stops looking out for his lost son, whilst keeping a constant love for the older boy. At this point, the half-way mark through Lent, the purple gives way to rose/pink and the Church cries our 'Laetare! Rejoice!' In this country we celebrate Mothering Sunday - and British Summer Time has come! There is so much to think about, reflect on and do, with Easter that bit closer.

How do you regard the Father in the Gospel reading from St. Luke? Is he foolish to welcome back his son? Is he wise to restore him to his place in the household, throwing such a lavish party for him? Is the younger one likely to do the same all over again? Can you walk in the shoes of the older boy who is so faithful and committed to his responsibilities? Would you have rejoiced at your younger brother's return or gone into the celebration? Many questions, a variety of responses, a diversity of views! 'Of course, it's only a story', I find myself saying. Nevertheless, it is one of the most beautiful and brilliant told by Jesus and he does so because of the complaining religious people who cannot stomach the scene of Jesus in the company of sinners. The picture presented puts us in touch with God, heaven and earth - huge, rich, reconciling love offered to all which results in a divine celebration. How easy it can be to begrudge God his mercy or feel he just doesn't know what he is doing. Please take time this week to allow the power of this parable to touch your hearts and contemplate the response God is drawing from you.

With the devastating cyclone in south-eastern Africa, CAFOD has asked us to have another Lenten collection to support our suffering brothers and sisters abroad. This will be next weekend. I'm sure you can use the special CAFOD envelopes to GiftAid your contribution. Also, our Cardinal has asked us to observe Friday 12th April as a Day of Prayer for Survivors of Abuse. More about this next week. Furthermore, the Cardinal has drawn our attention to the horror of knife crime; there will be a rally in Trafalgar Square on Saturday 6th April 2.00 - 4.00pm entitled 'Standing together'. The Cardinal will be there and invites parishioners to join him. The rally will share the lament of those who have lost loved ones; in addition, it will proclaim the goodness of so many young people - thus the voice of hope will resound! Like the Father in the parable, may our hearts reach out to the suffering; may God's love bring justice, healing, reconciliation and peace.

There will be the **early morning 6.30 Mass** at St. Bonaventure's this Friday (5th April) and the **Restoration Holy Hour** at Our Lady's on Friday 12th April after Stations of the Cross (around 8pm).
