

Fifth Sunday of Easter 19th May page 271 of the Mass Book

As I read today's Gospel from St. John, I am struck by the challenge of what it means to be a disciple of the Risen Lord. Let us reflect on some elements of the passage.

At the Last Supper Jesus was gathered with his friends, his disciples. And yet one was going to betray him; another was going to deny that he knew him. Jesus wanted to share with them the most intimate knowledge he had of God - from the Father's Right Hand - and, in turn, asked them to pass this on to others. How could Judas do what he did? Why did he fall into this act of betrayal? There are no easy answers but this is a reminder of how easy it can be to find ourselves doing exactly the opposite of what we intend. Peter's protest that he would die for Christ certainly did not evidence itself immediately, but later after the Resurrection of Jesus and the outpouring of the Spirit, he would bear witness to the Lord by his martyrdom in Rome.

'Glorify' is a strange word to us nowadays. Jesus is glorified; God is glorified; God glorifies the Son. There is mutual glory! It is expressed in a context of obedience, imminent pain, being a servant, the act of letting go. A completely topsy-turvy kind of 'glory'! What does this say to us as followers of Jesus? Firstly, we are called to be caught up in this glory: offering it to God and receiving it from God through our listening, our willingness to suffer, our reaching out in service and our readiness to let go. The glory of this present moment gives us glimpse of what is still to come. It definitely is worth having a taste now of what eternity is going to be like!

Do people around you know that you are a disciple of Jesus? Jesus commands us to love as he has loved us. That is hard! To love sacrificially, to love unconditionally, to love offering total forgiveness. He knows that if we keep this commandment the world will be renewed by all that we do and that so many others will want to be like us because we offer something totally new - we offer Jesus Christ, God's Son!

Let us pray that the Lord's Spirit will give us the strength we need.
