

SS Peter and Paul 30th June page 180 of the Mass Book

Today the Church invites us to honour the great Apostles, Peter and Paul. These two men are pivotal in the life of the Church and yet are so different! St. Peter, we are told in the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark and Luke) is called to leave his nets and follow Jesus; when the disciples are asked who they think Jesus is, it is Peter who articulates faith (as we hear in Sunday's reading from St. Matthew). In St. John's Gospel, Simon Peter is introduced to Jesus by his brother Andrew and it is Jesus who looks at Simon and says he is to be called 'Cephas' which means Rock. Saturday evening's Gospel passage from St. John outlines the encounter of Simon Peter with Jesus after the Resurrection when three times, Peter is asked if he loves the Lord and the three affirmatives make up for the three denials before Jesus' death. St. Peter goes on to give his life for Christ in the city of Rome thus establishing it as the centre not only of the Roman Empire but the heart of Christianity whence the Good News will radiate to every corner of the earth.

Paul is an educated man! His following of the Pharisaic ways gives him the confidence to persecute the followers of 'The Way' - Christians. Paul really does meet Jesus but the circumstances and the effects are distinct: Jesus speaks to him personally, the 'old' Saul becomes a new person with the name 'Paul', the persecutor becomes the proclaimer and servant of the Gospel not only for the Jewish People but for the pagans who are transformed by the power of the message. Paul is able to put in writing what he has seen and heard, who he has experienced and grown to love. He too gives his life for Christ in Rome and shares with St. Peter in the great act of martyrdom for the sake of Christ and his Church.

So what about you and me? Like Peter and Paul, we are very different! The Lord calls out to us and he waits for our decisive responses to him. He has a role for us to play in the continuing building up of the Kingdom and he empowers us with grace to carry out the Mission. Don't wait for someone else! Let your relationship with the Lord blossom - no matter what! Let the Spirit which moved in the lives of the Apostles fire you up on ways you never thought possible. Bear witness - be a Martyr - of Jesus Christ. Have a good week. *Fr. Norbert*
