

Life is full of questions! Sometimes the answers are obvious; at other times they elude us. Some are simple and basic; others really deep, taking us to the essence of who we are. In our Gospel passage from St. Luke there is a lawyer who asks Jesus a question. The Lord poses another to him and the result is a really good response. The lawyer puts a further question to the Lord and we are then given the wonderful parable of the Good Samaritan. Christ probes deeper and the lawyer's answer is spot on. Then the final twist and challenge: 'Go and do the same yourself.' We don't discover what ensues!

Remember we are on this significant journey with Jesus as he makes his way to Jerusalem. Ponder how he makes time for so many different types of people, finding just the right word for a particular person in his or her situation. Often we find this difficult! We are busy, not having enough time. The questions put to us might be beyond us or require a lengthy answer. Maybe it's a stranger who comes our way? Perhaps someone close to us? The parable of the Good Samaritan presents us with the image of a stranger who takes time and gives of his own personal resources to help someone in dire need. He acts quickly and decisively, not losing any time in making a decision as to what to do. Jesus can at times leave us feeling quite uncomfortable as he asks each one of us to 'go and do the same yourself.' Love evidenced in action is a hallmark of our love for God and neighbour.

We are now coming to the end of the academic year. The school holidays are upon us! This affects us in a variety of ways: a different schedule, time for rest and refreshment, responsibilities changing etc. I am very grateful to the staff and governors of our schools for their hard work in ensuring the very best for our children and young people. Our parents have such a significant role in the development of the young. May the faith and love put into action in our schools bear much fruit. God bless you all.
