

## Twenty-second Sunday of the Year 1st September page 130 of Mass Book

Welcome back to everyone who has been away! Happy holidays to those preparing to leave. I hope the summer has been kind to all who have spent these months at home. Here in our parishes it is a time of transition. Today we bid 'Adieu!' to Fr. Tom and get ready for the arrival of Fr. Tony. I start my twelfth year as your Parish Priest. The new Parish Centre is well on its way and is on course for completion by next summer. In the coming year the town of Welwyn Garden City will be celebrating its centenary - what an achievement! I'm sure that there will be many key moments in which we will share together with the other Christian Churches and the wider Community. There is a huge amount of building work going on across our area which means that new families, couples and individuals will take up residence in our midst. A good proportion, I am sure, will be Catholics and so it is crucial that they feel at home in our churches. Possibly some newcomers might be interested in joining the Catholic Church and so we will have the responsibility of introducing them to the riches and joy of Faith.

In our Second Reading today from the Letter to the Hebrews, the passage starts with the words: 'What you have come to is...' The Author gives his community the feeling that they have already arrived at Mount Zion, the heavenly Jerusalem, with all it has to offer especially Jesus Christ our Mediator. Those hearing this excerpt would have got so excited to think that their present experience was a taste of what was still to come, and that what they could not achieve themselves, Christ would realise through his Blood shed on Calvary. There is a sense of the already-but-not-yet! How does that speak to you today as we begin a 'new' year? Gathered at church with loved ones, friends and family, or as a fresh arrival or visitor, do you really have a glimpse of heaven? Can you feel Christ's presence and his reconciling love? Does it only seem like an unachievable dream? The Eucharist puts us in touch with heaven and with the Event of the Lord's Death and Resurrection. The transforming Spirit which consecrates the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of God's Son, holds us together forming Community and creating Communion with so many across the world and across the ages. Heaven is in our midst! Let this be our aspiration and hope.
