

Money! Do you have enough or too much? Are you careful with what you have or are you ready to gamble it away or share it with others? This week and next St. Luke presents us with parables about the use of money. Remember Jesus is still on the way to Jerusalem accompanied by hordes of people. Something must have made him stop to speak in this way. We are not told the reason but surely it must have had to do with the attitude of people around him?

In the first parable which we hear this Sunday, we are made aware of a steward who is about to lose his job and takes it upon himself to make friends with his master's debtors. This is a really complicated parable which appears to condone dishonesty; I would imagine that when first told, the Lord was challenging people to make a decision for the Kingdom, to use their wherewithal and resourcefulness in order to enter the Kingdom of God. St. Luke then gathers many sayings of Jesus about money and lays them before us! We have to listen hard!

Next Sunday if we haven't got the message, we are challenged further by the parable of Lazarus and the Rich Man. The latter is totally oblivious to the suffering of the poor, destitute man at his gate and lives in splendour, wining and dining. Death is the leveller and the Rich Man finds himself suffering while Lazarus is comforted in the bosom of Abraham. It's too late for the Rich Man who then pleads for his brothers to be saved; he is reminded that they have Moses and the prophets to read. This parable puts us on the spot: do we open our eyes to the person in need? What is our lifestyle like? Do we pay heed to the Scriptures?

In the coming weeks, let us focus on Christ and the Kingdom he proclaims and embodies. Let us learn from him to open our hearts to those around us in need. Let us use our money and possessions wisely. He wants us to live for ever with him! What do we truly desire and what changes should we make to help ourselves on the journey?

NEW PARISH CENTRE The Cardinal's Growing in Faith Campaign has come to an end in Welwyn Garden City. Over the last 5 years, many parishioners have generated around £550k of which £252k has come back to our parishes for the joint project of the building of the new Parish Centre for our churches. Fr. Norbert understands that letters are being sent out personally from the Diocese to thank individuals for their generosity. Also, an invitation to continue contributing towards the Building Fund for the new WGC Parish Centre may be included; this will help pay off the remaining debt which will be incurred. In due course, we will be offering other parishioners who were not part of the Growing in Faith campaign or perhaps are new to our parishes the opportunity of supporting the completion of the Centre.
