Today is the World Day of the Poor. Caritas Westminster has made available 'Advent Giving Calendars' which are the back of the church. Each day there is a suggestion of items to collect for a local food bank or food poverty project in time for Christmas. In our own area there is a food bank co-ordinated by New Zion Christian Fellowship which is on Cole Green Lane, opposite Sweet Briar. In every church in the area there are baskets where donations are made and these in turn go to New Zion where they are distributed very Wednesday 9 - 11am. Vouchers are given out by various agencies and these in turn are 'redeemed'. The pastors at New Zion are always delighted at the huge generosity of our Catholic community, so please keep up that giving! Other local projects worthy of support are our own SVP - the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, which meets at St. Bonaventure's, the local YMCA Hostel in Peartree Lane and the Women's Refuge in this area. On this important day with just 5 weeks or so till Christmas, please consider supporting those in need.

On a totally different note, our Gospel reading from St. Luke is about the end! When will it be? How will we know? What signs should we look for? Jesus is very clear that it will not be easy, that we should persevere, that we will be given the right words to say. Finally, our endurance will win us our lives. The Lord wants us not to think only of the immediate but to look ahead to our destiny his desire for us to live for ever with him. He suffered and he understands our trials; he longs for us to come through tribulation to glory, following in his footsteps. This other aspect of November is quite challenging: we remember and pray for the dead, whilst not forgetting that there will be a culmination of time and that the world as we know will reach its conclusion. In the Book of Revelation, we are given wonderful imagery of a New Heaven and New Earth, coming down in our midst, where Christ will be the Lamp shining out and the song of the Angel and Saints will be resonating for eternity. God wants us to be there!
