

### Second Sunday of Advent 8th December page 85 of the Mass Book

John the Baptist has arrived! The Herald of Jesus Christ is on the scene! When I think of a herald, I imagine a person in a special uniform with a bell in hand and crying out 'Oyez! Oyez!' There is silence called for and then a proclamation is made. Usually there is rejoicing at good news if that is the case. And then what?

In our Gospel reading today from St. Matthew, the Baptist is wearing amazing garb and feasting on exotic delights - camel hair, locusts and wild honey! The Evangelist presents us with a picture of hordes of people making their way to the wilderness of Judaea. What was their motivation? To see this strange man? To hear his message? To follow everyone else like sheep? Maybe a longing to be transformed by news which was fresh and hopeful? John's voice urges the crowds to repent; he proclaims that the kingdom of heaven is close at hand. Repentance is a turning around, a new beginning and a refocus on God. The 'kingdom' is revealed in a person - Jesus Christ; and his coming is imminent. What would they have made of the Baptist's assault on the Pharisees and Sadducees?

How do we as Church understand John's harsh words about 'presuming' things? John the Baptist and then Christ himself want the fruits of repentance to be evident. God wants us all to be saved! Perhaps this week we might set time to reflect on what it really means for us to be God's children because of our belonging to the Church and our bond with Jesus. Are we living up to the calling? Is change required? Do we take it all for granted or put our faith on hold in the every day? The Church asks us to grasp the seriousness of the fact that the Lord is coming in glory and that we need to prepare a way for him.

Let us pray for our country as we go to the polls on Thursday. God's Spirit and his inspiration surely are crucial as we make decisions for our own lives and for future generations. Whatever the outcome, let us beg the Lord to bring us harmony, justice and hope.
