
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Everything is moving so quickly, locally, nationally and internationally with the coronavirus pandemic. The Bishops of England and Wales have issued guidelines which we must carry out. Exercise great caution with hygiene. Keep in phone contact with those you know who may be isolated. It is a complicated time in history and in some ways many things we take for granted or do on autopilot will need careful thought and response. Some countries have already taken the decision to 'lockdown'. If this happened here, we would have to comply. This would be unprecedented for the huge majority of the population. The parish website www.wgc-catholics.org.uk is the best way of checking the 'latest' in our three churches. Obviously not everyone is on-line, but maybe we could keep those we know informed by phone or text.

Today we start a series of Gospel readings from St. John. In all three passages there is an encounter between Jesus and various people: first the Samaritan woman at the well (chapter 4), then the man who was born blind who received sight from Jesus (chapter 9) and finally Martha and Mary whose brother Lazarus is raised from the dead (chapter 11). Jesus crosses religious barriers, he calls people to a decision in faith - he makes a difference! Through conversation and disputation, we are led deeper and deeper into the mystery of who Jesus is: the Saviour of the world, the Light of the world, the Resurrection and the Life. Find these passages in your Bible or on-line; mull over the words, phrases, imagery and meaning. Let this Word of God nourish and sustain you in the midst of the uncertainty we face at this time.

Let us pray for one another and intercede for our world. May God shower his blessings upon us all.
