Palm Sunday 28th March 2021

'Why are you doing this?' is the question Jesus suggests will be put to the two disciples who search for the colt on which Jesus will ride into Jerusalem in St. Mark's Gospel. This passage will start our Palm Sunday Masses as we commemorate the Lord's entrance into Jerusalem. Jesus told the pair to respond with the answer 'The Lord has need...' Let's take time to reflect on the question and the answer.

In Holy Week we find ourselves doing many different or unusual things! Obviously this time round it will be unique in a time of pandemic with some of you still shielding or isolating at home while others are able to come to church. Perhaps the routine of our lives will be disrupted as we remember the amazing events of Jesus' last days and the impact they have had on our identity and our destiny? Salvation is made known in Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection. Our response is crucial as we re-live the saving act of the Lord; we open up ourselves totally to the life-giving, sacrificial love which flows from the Wood of the Cross. God-in-his-Son offers forgiveness, healing, peace, hope and eternal life. Jesus-on-behalf-of-humanity reveals a wonderful, mind-blowing response of a human heart to all that God offers us. Surely the Lord has need of us? He longs for us to be saved and come closer to a deeper experience of his eternal Kingdom.

This year in church, the Services will be so different! Why? We are keeping to Government guidelines and those of the Bishops' Conference which are aiming to keep those who gather as safe as possible. There will be fewer readings from Scripture. On Maundy Thursday there will not be the Washing of Feet at the Mass of the Lord's Supper nor the opportunity to spend time at the Altar of Repose afterwards.

On Good Friday at the Solemn Passion, there will be a collective veneration (adoration) of the Cross. At the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday Night, no fire or Blessing of Water, nothing elaborate so that we remain in church for 40 minutes or so. Last year no one was allowed to be present - only streamed Services; this year a congregation but the ceremonies reduced to their very essence. Nothing can stop God's grace! It will come. We just have to be ready to accept his firm offer and the lavishing of love in fresh ways. Take time to ponder anew how God touches your heart this Easter 2021.

Fr. Tony and I pray for you; remember us. This year more than ever we must let our homes be filled with the holiness of God's presence as Holy Week unfolds. We should be ready to witness the blessings which await us. May you and your loved ones be blessed in every possible way by the Lord.

FIRST CONFESSIONS Please pray for our children who will be making their First Confession this coming week that the joy of celebrating God's forgiving love in Jesus may bring them and their families many blessings.

CHRISM MASS will be celebrated by the Cardinal at Westminster Cathedral on the Tuesday of Holy Week. The Cardinal will bless the Oil of the Sick (used to anoint those who are seriously ill), the Oil of Catechumens (to anoint children and adults in readiness for Baptism) and the Oil of Chrism (used at Baptism, Confirmation, Ordination and the at the Consecration of a Church or Altar). Priests present will also renew their Priestly Promises. As Dean, Fr. Norbert will then collect the Holy Oils and will take them to the parishes of Stevenage Deanery: Royston, Baldock, Letchworth Garden City, Hitchin, Stevenage, Knebworth, Hatfield and Welwyn Garden City itself. It will be an opportunity to say 'Hello' to the clergy (at a distance) and make sure everyone is well.

SACRAMENTS

Current regulations apply at least until 29th March, 2021

Baptism is NOT permitted outside of communal worship.

Weddings are possible (in limited circumstances) with 6 present. If you are planning to get married this year or next in WGC or beyond, please let Fr. Norbert know so that the necessary preparation and paperwork can be organised.

Funerals can take place with 30 mourners maximum.

Confirmation 2020 New dates have been set.
