Easter Sunday 17th April 2022 including Second Sunday of Easter 24th April

A new beginning! God's Son who died on the Cross has risen from the dead - ALLELUIA! We have completed Lent and walked with the Lord through the Sacred Triduum. Now we bask in the light of the Resurrection for 50 days. I can remember trying to keep an Easter egg for each day of the Easter Season, to keep alive the joy of the Eastertide - not such a good idea in terms of sugar and one's figure!

Think about this year 2022 and what will help you keep alive the strength of your faith in the Risen Lord. What are you grateful to God for? How does Easter impact on your motivation and your hopes for the future? Would you be able each day for the next 50 days to find something or someone you want to say 'Thank you' to God for? This year we have the new members who have joined the Church - congratulations and blessings. There are people who have come to church for the first time and feel welcome - wonderful! There are those who have moved to the area from other parts of this country or from abroad - let's hope they settle down very quickly. He understands our sufferings and how overwhelming they can be. The agony of our world is at the heart of his self-giving; so, we hand over to him Ukraine and other lands torn apart by strife. Every time we celebrate the Eucharist, we are immersed in the joyful thanksgiving of Easter which radiates from his Cross and then the Tomb.
