

HOLY FAMILY

30th Sunday of the Year 23rd October 2022

Prayer was essential in the life of Jesus Christ and he desires that it be at the heart of who we are as his followers. St. Luke gives us parables about prayer - persistent (as last week) and with the right frame of mind (this Sunday). Prayer is our connection with God, in and through his Beloved Son Jesus Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit. It is two-way and involves an attentiveness to God as well as an offering of what we need. It demands acknowledging our dependence on God and it informs how we regard and treat others. The Lord wants us to learn to pray even more and deepen the experience.

Prayer in its many facets was at the centre of the visit of St. Bernadette's relics to Stevenage earlier in the week. I had the privilege of sharing in what had been prepared, and was celebrated, in the short space of 20 hours! Children were immersed in the message of Lourdes as they gathered in St. Vincent de Paul School: there was an outdoor shrine of Our Lady, a well-being walk and the creating of banners and exquisite imitation-reliquaries containing the beads of one decade of the Rosary. Adults and secondary school students prayed with the children and helped them feel the Lourdes experience. There was a huge sense of expectation as we waited outside St. Joseph's Church for the relics to arrive and, as they were carried in, all followed with yellow roses to remind us of the roses in Our Lady's feet when she appeared to St. Bernadette. Throughout the day people streamed into the church to honour the reliquary and to pray: in silence and stillness, reciting the Rosary or queueing to come closer to the relics. It was such a powerful expression of faith and truly a taste of our Catholic tradition. I was hearing Confessions non-stop and helped with the Anointing of the Sick. Finally at the end of Monday the Bishop celebrated Mass and there was a candlelight procession outdoors. It was magical and heavenly! For me, it was then a dash back to WGC, a few hours' sleep and then the return to Stevenage for 7am Mass. It was wonderful seeing so many people, having a time of contemplation, and celebrating Mass on the feast of St. Luke.

I am so grateful on behalf of our Deanery to Fr. Nigel Woollen and the team of parishioners and friends who created an environment of warmth and welcome, of joyful faith and outreach, and keeping us safe and secure in a unique moment of local history. This truly was faith-in-action and prayerful self-sacrifice. I invite you this week to reflect on prayer in YOUR life and how it can be enriched and extended.
