
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



33rd Sunday of the Year 13th November 2022

Last Sunday the heavens opened as we blessed the graves at Hatfield Lawn Cemetery! I can't remember it ever having been so wet. And yet people came, prayed together and stood by the graves of their loved ones, some of whom had died a long time ago as well as the more recent dead. It was not an afternoon for chatting - just a quick dash to the car after the sprinkling of Holy Water! Today we'll bless more graves at Hatfield Hyde near Our Lady's and follow with the Remembrance Day Service at the War Memorial. I remember one year giving the address and seeing the faces of so many uniformed young people standing to attention but with the rain dripping down their faces. Someone held an umbrella over my head; the youngsters were not allowed to avail of any such protection. It was an impressive moment seeing all those gathered to recall the sacrifice and devotion of so many for the sake of generations to come.

In our Gospel passage today from St. Luke, Jesus speaks to those around him, telling them about 'The End' with amazing signs, betrayal, suffering and woes. It is so frightening to be reminded about the end of time and yet Jesus keeps us focused on the culmination of all things. Two words he uses are, I think, essential: witness and endurance. The Lord asks us to bear witness to him, to speak his words, relying on the gifts to be offered to us of eloquence and wisdom. We hear from the Lord's lips that endurance will win us our lives. Keep going...never give up! We think about the resilience needed by those protecting us and other lands; we reflect on how we face personal crises and disappointments, determining to be steadfast. None of this is easy and the inspiration of God will enable us to carry this out.

As November moves on, let us continue to pray for the dead that they may be raised to eternal life. Let us pray for the bereaved that healing comfort may be a hallmark of this month.

FIRST CONFESSION & FIRST HOLY COMMUNION There will be an enrolment meeting for parents and children from St. Bonaventure, Holy Family and Our Lady's on Tuesday 22nd November at 6pm in Our Lady's Church. The meeting should last around 40 minutes and dates will be given for the preparation and the First Holy Communions which will be celebrated in all three churches. Children should be at least in Year 3 at school.

CONFIRMATION Enrolment for young people for Confirmation will be on Sunday 27th November at 7pm in Holy Family Church. Bishop Paul McAleenan has given us Friday 9th June 2023 as the date for Confirmation here in Welwyn Garden City. Young people need to be at least in Year 9 at school and should come with their parent/s to the meeting which will last around 40 minutes. Dates for preparation will be given that day.

RCIA The Rite of the Christian Initiation of Adults for adults who would like to join the Catholic Church will next meet on Monday 21st November at 7.30pm in the Sacristy of Our Lady's. This is also a great way for adults, who missed out on Confirmation when they were younger, to prepare for Confirmation. In some countries you cannot get married in the Catholic Church if not confirmed. The meeting will last an hour. Last Monday there were 11 adults who came plus 3 apologies. Still time to join. Please speak to Fr. Norbert if you want to find out more.

PARISHES MERGER Fr. Norbert presented the proposal of merging our three parishes into One-Parish-with-three-churches to the Diocesan Council of Priests last Wednesday. Apart from one abstention, there was total agreement from the priests. The Cardinal will inform Fr. Norbert of the next steps. Fr. Norbert will keep you posted as he receives more information.
