Christ the King 26th November 2017 p. 158 of Mass book

‘I tell you solemnly, in so far as you did this to one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did it to me.’ These are the challenging words of Jesus in today’s Gospel reading from St. Matthew as we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. What do you hear the Lord saying to you personally today? What will be your response this week? How do you hope to carry out his will and thus share in life eternal?

This parable challenges us to open our eyes - wide! This parable forces us to look - and really look! This parable is uncompromising and so many of us will feel we have fallen short of what the Lord asks! When I encounter someone in need, does this person become a problem or is it Christ I see? When I am in a difficult and desperate situation, am I aware that Christ is so close to me and waiting to be served? As I reach out to the person who comes my way seeking help, can I truly believe that the Kingdom of God is breaking in and that Christ reigns in me and in that individual? What a strange Kingdom! The Lord gives us this powerful, thought-provoking imagery as he gets ready for his own Passion, Death and Resurrection! As the Church’s Year draws to a close this last Sunday in Ordinary Time, let us pray that the effects of reflecting on St. Matthew’s Gospel this past year will stay with us, that we will remember that in Jesus God is with us!

I write these words just before setting off for the Holy Land, which is sometimes referred to as the ‘Fifth Gospel’! To be standing in places where Jesus was, to behold scenes he might have seen, to feel the influence of his presence in his homeland - these are some of our aspirations as we journey to the Terra Santa. The Gospel is a living experience of Good News which has been proclaimed; the Gospel is the proclamation of Good News which has been experienced! And whether we are walking in the Holy Land or you step on the pavements of Welwyn Garden City, the Lord definitely finds ways of sharing with us, and invigorating us with, the power of his message.
