

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion 14th April page 190 of the Mass Book

We have nearly arrived! Today, on Palm Sunday, we enter Jerusalem with Jesus and so begin Holy Week. Each day we will get closer to the Sacred Easter Triduum (Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday-into-Easter Sunday) with the intensity of Christ's love poured out generously upon the human race, bringing us salvation. This year, the schools are well into their Easter holidays and the calendar is speeding through April - thus creating a strange kind of feeling! Nevertheless we must not forget that these Three Days define our identity as Christians: we re-live the moments of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection, we remember and experience once more the saving grace, we are drawn more deeply into the eternal life of God made visible in his Beloved Son, the Incarnate Word who triumphed over sin and death...we are even nearer to heaven!

Today we will be meditating on the Passion following St. Luke. In this Gospel Jesus prays: "Father, forgive them; they do not know what they are doing." We also have the encounter between the Good Thief and Jesus summed up as follows: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom"... "Today you will be with me in paradise." Jesus concludes his Passion with the words: "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." Just ponder these last hours in Jesus' life as he forgives, promises and prays - all in the midst of acute pain and suffering. These are not empty words but the powerful expression of God's Son calling out to his Father and longing for us to share with him in the forgiveness and eternal life which flow from the Cross. Are there people we still need to forgive or be open to their forgiveness? Are there promises we have not kept or which we should make to God? Can we use our voices to pray to our God who is approaching us through his Son us and is offering us everything?

As a community we will be blessed with the presence of many visitors in our midst this week; others will be away celebrating with family and friends elsewhere. May God watch over us all with tender care and guide us safely and lovingly to the glory of Easter next Sunday.

Let us pray for each other!

LENT During this final week of Lent, there will be **Stations of the Cross** on Wednesday at Holy Family (after 9.30 Mass). There will be **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** for 30 minutes on Monday at Our Lady's (after 9.30 Mass. The **Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession)** will be on Thursday at Holy Family (9.30 - 10.30am), Saturday at St. Bonaventure's (10.00 - 11.00am). The main **Service of Reconciliation** for Welwyn Garden City will be on Tuesday 16th at 8pm at Our Lady's at which there will be 5 priests available.

EASTER VIGIL MUSIC The music rehearsal for the Easter Vigil will be on Monday 15th April at 7pm in Our Lady's Church. All are welcome.

GOOD FRIDAY EVENING SERVICE is a time of reflection at 8pm at Our Lady's, a chance to think back over the events of the day. There will be Scripture, music, silence and chance to pray before the Cross. It will last 45/50 minutes. Everyone is welcome.

ELLEN BROPHY RIP Nellie's Funeral Mass will be at Holy Family Church on Wednesday 17th April at 12.30pm.

WALSINGHAM This year on Saturday 18th May, we will have a coach going to Walsingham in Norfolk. The Shrine dates back to 1061 and has been a place of pilgrimage for centuries. It is always a glorious day and we have the joy of joining the National Deaf Pilgrimage. We will leave from Our Lady's Church at 8am, arriving in time for a Service in the village at 12 noon. Fr. Norbert has been asked to lead this Service and the 'signing group' from WGC will help with the signed hymns. We will then walk the Holy Mile into the Catholic Shrine. There'll be a picnic lunch (please bring food and drink!), Mass and time to visit the Slipper Chapel, cream tea or ice-creams and we'll depart at 5pm. Please fill out a form available at the back of our churches to secure a place on the coach. Price £15 adults and £10 for children.

CHRISM MASS will be on Tuesday 16th April at 12 noon at Westminster Cathedral. If you are free, why not come and see the Blessing of the Holy Oils and the Cardinal, Bishops and priests renew their Promises?

FIRST COMMUNION RETREAT DAY Just to remind the First Communion families that they have their Afternoon Retreat at St. Albans on Sunday 28th April starting at 12.30pm. First Communion Masses will be on Sundays as follows: Our Lady's 12th May and 9th June at 11.30am, Holy Family 19th May 12 noon and St. Bonaventure's 16th June at 10.30am.

CHILDREN'S EASTER WORKSHOP AT ST. BONAVENTURE'S There is an Easter Workshop for children this Tuesday 16th April from 2- 4pm. Come and help plant our outdoor Easter Garden, make your own garden, make some Easter things, join in an Easter egg hunt, prepare for our Way of the Cross, have a 'Happy Easter Tea' (bring and share) and listen to the Easter story. £2 per child to cover some of our costs.

NEW PARISH CENTRE The builders should take possession of the site on Monday 29th April and the demolition of the old hall will follow. The project should take 12 'working' months, so our new Parish Centre would be ready by summer 2020. To get ready for the April date, we will need to have many helping hands to prepare items for storage and muscle to take things up the church tower into the rooms for safe keeping for the next year. On **Friday 26th April at 11am**, we are looking for volunteers to help wrap up glasses etc and box them up. On the same day from **6.30pm**, we will move these boxes and furniture which is to be kept into the tower rooms. A number of parishioners have offered to help; if anyone else is free, please let Fr. Norbert know. On **Sunday 28th April between 7pm and 8pm** the hall will be open for whatever is left to being taken by parishioners.
