LEGISLATION Our Bishops have asked us to write to our MPs about some very important issues coming up in Parliament. On Wednesday 15th May, MPs will be given the opportunity to vote on two pro-life changes to the law—one amendment to the Criminal Justice Bill tabled by Caroline Ansell MP to lower the abortion limit from 24 to 22 weeks, and another tabled by Liam Fox MP which would bring the abortion limit for babies with Down's Syndrome in line with the time limit for babies who do not have disabilities. At present abortion for Down's Syndrome is legal right up to birth.
