The Church cannot let go of Easter completely and before we are fully immersed in Ordinary Time, we are given two profound and amazing celebrations - the Most Holy Trinity and Corpus Christi (the Body and Blood of Christ). If I asked you to write about each of these mysteries, how many pages would you need? There are tomes written by scholars which try to outline how God can be Three-in-One as well as One-in-Three. The number of books explaining how Christ can be present in the Bread and Wine which are transformed by God through the words and actions of the priest. The Trinity and Eucharist are at the heart of our belief as Catholic Christians. As we profess our faith in the Trinity, we are taken to the essence of God who calls us to share in his dynamic, vibrant life - one day we hope this will be our experience for eternity. Our Gospel passage is the ending of St. Matthew as the Lord sends out his disciples to baptise 'in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.' He promises to be with us to the end of time. The Gospel for Corpus Christi is from St. Mark. We are at the Last Supper and Christ's Gift will help us to remember his Passion, Death and Resurrection. The eternal love of the Trinity is made manifest in the Saving Passion of Christ. His love is for everyone and brings us all together.
