In our Gospel passages from St. Mark for these two Sundays, the word 'kingdom' appears a number of times. What is it like? How does it grow? Who is the source of its being? There are so many questions to ask ourselves, to reflect on, ideas to be actioned and lived out. The Kingdom is very much about a person - Jesus Christ - and he is the revelation of the Father's intention for the Divine to be in our midst.

On Friday 21st June I have been asked to preach at a Novena in St. Paul's Church, Wood Green. The theme I have been given is *Thy Kingdom Come* - a phrase we know all too well from the Lord's Prayer. What do those three words mean for you? They trip off our tongues with frequency together with many other words. What do YOU intend as you speak/recite/pray them? When something becomes very familiar, there is a danger of the sense/intention/depth getting lost as we utter the regular pattern. In these coming weeks I shall be looking out for signs of the Kingdom, listening intently for a word which communicates life, opening up my heart and being to an experience of Christ's Presence from the Father which roots me in the Kingdom and in turn sends me out with even more to share and discover. The Kingdom is dynamic and it cannot be encapsulated by only one word or phrase. The Kingdom is a royal, majestic and noble breaking in of God's life-giving, sacrificial love into the every day human experience. We discover our role and our place; we cooperate with the Lord in building up the Kingdom.
