Today the Church celebrates Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We are given a Gospel passage from St. Luke which harmonises so much with the Last Supper as Jesus takes...looks up to heaven...says a blessing...breaks and gives. Those who are famished after a whole day in his company eat and are satisfied! The disciples, who initially wanted to send the people away, act as the Lord's instruments in sharing the broken bread. Nothing is wasted as the fragments left over are collected! The Mass defines who we are as Catholic Christians. We remember the Lord's Sacrifice and are immersed in the love of Calvary. We proclaim his Resurrection and taste of his Risen Body. We are filled with the Holy Spirit lavished upon us by the Lord. Heaven and earth are together in One Act of Worship. Over the years I have never ceased to be amazed at the fresh experiences God gives me in the Eucharist. There are insights, people, life's highest and lowest points. There's the ordinary suffused with the divine. There's what I expect and then an overwhelming moment of Divine Presence bursting into my life. I am so grateful to God for this precious Gift which sustains us in our lives and opens us up to his peace. Is Holy Communion a reward for being *good*? Is it a medicine for the *sick*? Is it only my connection *with Jesus Christ*? Is it my oneness with my brothers and sisters in the church, in the Church, on earth, in heaven? Perhaps you might take time to ponder some of these questions today? As you will see in the newsletter, there are changes happening in the coming months. We trust that God is at work and that the inspiration Jesus gave his disciples through seeing possibilities may be the reality guiding us into the future.
