Also, sometimes parents/carers, who have considered Baptism and First Holy Communion for a long time and never got round to it, should seek the next steps for the sake of their children.

**CARITAS WESTMINSTER** will be opening its first charity shop later this year to raise vital funds that will help better support the work of parishes and services, including the Deaf Service. There will be a **stock donation drive over the weekend of 19th – 20th July** here in our three churches. During this time, parishioners are invited to bring in any unwanted items suitable for donation. Caritas will sort donations and collect them soon after the weekend. *Keep this in mind just two weeks to go!*
