SVP ANNUAL REPORT 24/25 'During the 12 months ending March 25, 576 calls/visits were made to 73 Clients. The purpose of this contact is to provide assistance in the form of transport, financial help, shopping, keeping medical appointments, hospital visits and general face-to-face meetings. Our financial commitment includes: 21 families were given supermarket vouchers at Christmas 2024 and Easter 2025 amounting to £3000. Furniture, school uniforms and white goods were purchased for three Clients amounting to £350. We are supporting the South Sudan Appeal at £1000. Our SVP is assisting a student in India at a cost of £1000 (spread over 5 years). SVP was instrumental in organising the annual Mass With The Anointing of the Sick followed by refreshments at the Focolare Centre. Always such a joyous occasion! We are extremely grateful for the generosity of our parishioners who contribute financially throughout the year and at the SVP annual church collection as well as with giving of their time with practical assistance when requested. £1732 was raised following the 2024 collection.
