Welcome to Advent! A New Year in the Church's life and a fresh start. Our Sundays will principally be following St. Matthew's Gospel in which the emphasis is strongly on the Lord's Name - JESUS...the One who saves, and on EMMANUEL - God is with us. As we journey and reflect, keep thinking about the *salvation* he wants to bring you and the *presence* which is that of Divine, Perfect Love. As he has already come and since he is with us, why do we take these four Sundays *to prepare*? This is a huge question! How can you give of yourself in such a way as to bring someone else the wonder of the Lord's Coming? Time, material support, gifts, expressions of gratitude? It is a challenge to do everything but fidelity to Christ and an awareness of what Advent 2025 requires of you, might lead to a more focused and fruitful Season culminating in a wonderful and blessed Christmas!
